Advisements to Applicant:

- Except as otherwise provided by ordinance, the elevation information provided above must be accompanied by supporting documentation and certifications from a registered land surveyor or professional engineer.
- 2. Complete plans of the proposed improvements, including applicable floodplain requirements (such as foundation/flood opening details) must be submitted in conjunction with this application.
- 3. An as-built elevation certificate, certified by a registered land surveyor or professional engineer, must be submitted at the time of completion of the lowest floor prior to any further vertical construction.
- 4. If floodproofing is used for non-residential construction, a floodproofing certificate, certified by a professional engineer or architect, must be submitted at the time of completion of the lowest floor prior to any further vertical construction.
- 5. If the proposed development is located in an identified floodway, a no-rise certification completed by a registered professional engineer must be submitted prior to the issuance of a permit or the start of construction.
- 6. If the proposed development includes the alteration of a watercourse, a Letter of Map Revision issued by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) is required. This documentation must be submitted within 6 months of the completion of the project. Documentation that all other state or federal permitting required for the alteration of a watercourse has been obtained must be submitted as part of this application.
- 7. These advisements are not all encompassing. A copy of the town's Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance is available for review at the address provided on this form.
